Protest for blasted postman

THE dad of a postie left brain damaged after a gunman shot him in the face has told of his family's 'living nightmare'.

Innocent dad-of-two Robert Delaney was blasted at his home in Tallaght, Dublin, in 2008.

And Rob, 29, is in a vegetative state since.

His father Terry led a protest outside Eason's in Dublin yesterday – over the sale of new crime novel *Never Ending Justice* by John Noonan.

Noonan, 57, a convicted IRA man, was quizzed about the hit last month.

Terry said: "It's extremely difficult. It's like a nightmare."

Nobody has been charged over the shooting.
